### **SUPREME COURT RULES:**

#### **PROLIFERATION OF STEALTH CARTELS EMINENT**

Dallas, Texas- <http://www.StatesOnTheTake.com>, joins the growing consumer rights, legal and business groups which decry the High Court's recent ruling that has substantially degraded, if not destroyed the property rights of each and every Citizen Consumer across the country under the guise of economic development through "eminent domain."

StatesOnTheTake, the political corruption and citizen consumer activist site first joined the fight against the Stealth Cartel Partnerships of Big Business and States' Governments last year when it unearthed and published on the internet the "Privileged and Confidential" memo confirming the "Stealth Cartel" partnership between state governments and Big Tobacco, (<http://www.statesonthetake.com/memo.php>).

Since the inception of the site, StatesOnTheTake has fought to address the ever-expanding trend of "Stealth Cartel" partnerships whereby Big Business uses their comrade in collusion -- State Government as their preferred tool of choice to bully the Citizen Consumer and illegitimately undercut the competing independent small businesses. Initially, Exhibit Number 1 of these Stealth Cartels, was the Big Tobacco/States Settlement of 1998 (The Master Settlement Agreement -- "MSA"), however, in light of the high court's ruling, founder of StatesOnTheTake, S. George Alfonso expects the number of "Stealth Cartels" to proliferate across the country in numerous fields, adversely effecting more and more Citizen Consumers and independent business people.

"The Court's ruling is an affront to the property rights of every Citizen Consumer in this nation, and was recognized as such by several high Court dissenting justices" according to S. George Alfonso. Furthermore, Alfonso noted the irony that the Court stated that citizens should look to State Governments -- the very same partner to these Stealth Cartels and comrades in collusion with Big Business -- as the sole implementation of further protection to their property rights through the passage of laws through the respective state legislatures.

The high Court's surrendering of property rights to State governments only further affirms the need for the involvement of each and every independent business person and Citizen Consumer to join StatesOnTheTake in its' fight to Take Back State Government from the Big Business Stealth Cartels which are threatening to destroy this country's free market system.
